# The Impact of Women Peacekeepers on Public Support for Peacekeeping in Troop-Contributing Countries

Survey Sample Information and Demographics



PUBLIC SURVEY 1 (Mixed-Gender vs. All-Men Unit)

The sample includes approximately 1,000 respondents who passed the manipulation check (meaning that they were currently able to identify the gender composition of the unit after answering the outcome questions) and 125 who failed the manipulation check. Respondents were also asked about their support for various political parties in their country\*, their knowledge of UN peacekeeping, religion, and various demographic variables, such as their age and state of residence, to consider other factors that may influence their support for peacekeeping more generally and women peacekeepers in particular. Additionally, in India, respondents were asked about their ethnicity. Unfortunately, we were not able to ask about ethnicity or race in South Africa as the survey firm's policy did not allow for such questions due to concerns about the political sensitivity of race and ethnicity in South Africa.

Additionally, in India, respondents were asked about their ethnicity. Unfortunately, we were not able to ask about ethnicity or race in South Africa as the

survey firm's policy did not allow for such questions due to concerns about the political sensitivity of race and ethnicity in South Africa.
